2.7 – Student Satisfactory Survey

2.7.1 – Student Satisfaction Survey (SSS) on overall institutional performance (Institution may design the questionnaire) (results and details be provided as weblink)

In the year 2018-19 students' satisfactory survey was done on criteria of course, syllabus, library holdings for the course, internal evaluation system, weight age of course internal assessment system, students teacher relationships etc.

Analysis of students feedback report:

- 1 Most of the students are highly satisfied with the learning value of all Departments. (Learning value in term of skills, concepts, knowledge, analytical abilities, abrading perspectives)
- 2 Regarding applicability/ relevance to real life situation, majority of the students rated these as extremely good.
- 3 In respect of depth of the course content, most of the students marked it as extremely good and highly satisfied.
- 4 Regarding extent of effort required by the students, more than 67% of the students rated it as extremely good. Students are highly satisfied with the effort required by them.

5. More than 53% of students supported the relevance of learning value of the project given by the departments.

6. The overall ratings of the students were extremely good.

7 More than 73% of students considered the syllabus as challenging and 27% of students rated the syllabus as adequate.

8 Regarding course, 60% of students considered as relevant and 27% of students termed the course as highly relevant.

9. About 90% students opined that 90-95% syllabus was covered during the session.

10. More than 70% students considered the library materials for the respective courses as excellent.

11. Regarding prescribed readings, 70% of students rated it as good.

12. In terms of internal evaluation system, 60% of students rated it as very good. On the other hand 40% of students considered it as good.

13. 60% students viewed that the total weightage of the course in the internal assessment should be 25%.

14 Regarding the fair operating of the internal assessment system almost all the students agreed positively.

15. More than 60% of students felt superior when they had taken a similar programme at other universities

16. 70% of students rated as good, regarding student-teacher relationship in the college as a whole.

17. All most all the students rated as very good regarding the student –teacher relationship in the dept.

18. In terms of college administrative office 70% of students rated it as helpful.

19 About 60% of students rated the canteen facilities as good.

20. Regarding health care facilities, 60% of students rated it as very good and 40% of students rated as average.

21. 60% of students expressed their views that they participated regularly in extracurricular activities of the College.

22. All the students (100%) opined that the attitude of teachers towards extracurricular activities was encouraging.

23. About 70% of students expressed their views that their time at the college have been intellectually enriching.

23. Most of the student (73%) opined that they will talk proudly about the college.
